

Gravity Sewer - TPC Golf Course to the North Pumpback Station CMAR

This project includes the installation of large diameter gravity sewer and manholes to support future development in north Scottsdale. The pipe is being installed across the northern portion of the Tournament Players Club (TPC) Champions Course, with excavation depths up to 38 feet deep. Achen-Gardner's diligent safety practices, clean work areas, and consistent communication are allowing us to keep golfers safe and minimize disruptions during construction.
